ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENTS

Henderson Community College encourages students to apply for academic scholarships. These monetary awards vary from the cost of partial tuition to full-tuition and books. These scholarships can provide significant financial help to students to help defray the costs of an already affordable education.

Scholarship applicants are reviewed by the HCC Scholarship Committee. The committee determines the recipients on the basis of high school diploma level, GPA, and ACT scores. In some instances, the committee must award according to the guidelines established by private donors. To make the best use of scholarship funds, the college reserves the right to adjust any scholarship award to meet state and federal guidelines when those monies are involved.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Any student may apply for scholarships. It is unlikely, however, that a student would be considered for an award if he or she did not meet the following minimum standards:

1. Cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or better (4.00 scale).
2. Enroll as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more per semester).

WHEN DOES A STUDENT APPLY?

Students should begin the application process as early as possible to be considered for an academic scholarship in the upcoming fall semester.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS FEBRUARY 15, 2009

HOW DOES A STUDENT APPLY?

1. Submit the application on the next page.
2. Submit a seven semester high school transcript.
(including grades from the first semester of senior year)
3. Submit ACT score report.
4. Submit official college transcripts from other colleges or universities attended (if applicable).
